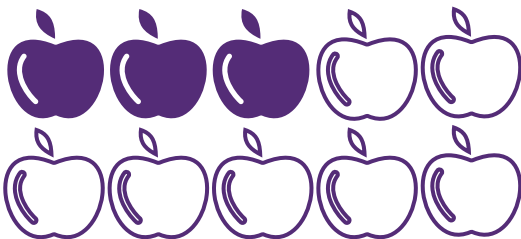
Gap between highest and lowest performing council district for all tests
