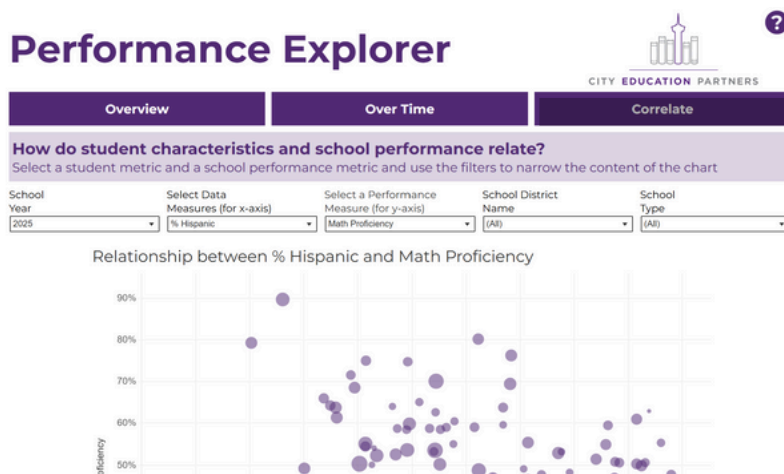
Our interactive Tableau tool is designed to complement the 2025 STAAR Data Report. Start by downloading and reviewing the report, then use this tool—along with the guide below—to explore the data in greater depth.

OVERVIEW

Each tab includes multiple filters to help you explore the data most relevant to your needs. Try different combinations to compare school types and see trends across different areas of San Antonio.

The dashboard currently displays STAAR test results and demographic data from 2022–2025, with plans to add future years as they become available.

TABS & AVAILABLE DATA

OVERVIEW

The first tab, “Overview,” mirrors the 2025 STAAR Data Report with **overall scores**. Use the drop-down menus to switch between years and subjects.

You can also click on a specific City Council District—either on the map or the bar graph—to filter the data for that district. By default, the dashboard displays data for the entire city.

The final graph highlights **Bright Spot Schools**—campuses we’ve identified for their combination of high academic performance and high percentages of economically disadvantaged students.

OVER TIME

The second tab, labeled “Over Time,” shows how **student performance has changed** from 2022 through the most recent scores in 2025. Use the available filters to drill down by multiple criteria, allowing you to **view trends** across the entire city or focus on a specific school.

Hover over any dot or line on the graph to see detailed school information.

The drop-down menu labeled “Performance Change” lets you group schools based on changes in performance, making it easier to identify and compare schools within each category.

DEFINITIONS

Chronically absent: Students missing more than 10% of school days (about 18 days) in a school year. The percentage shown is the share of enrolled students meeting this threshold.

Proficiency: The percentage of students scoring Meets Grade Level or above on the STAAR test for the selected year, shown for both reading and math.

School type:

Traditional Public School: Operated by a local school district.

Campus Charter: Public school authorized by a district but operated with a partner.

Open-Enrollment Charter: Public school operated by an approved operator, open to all students.

CORRELATE

The final tab, labeled “Correlate,” displays data in relation to different student demographics. Use this tab to explore how specific student populations are performing across the city. This view focuses on demographics rather than programs, helping to highlight trends and disparities by student group.
